The Commons Club Gold Membership Waitlist Policy April 25th, 2022

When the Club reaches its cap of 1,575 Gold memberships, a waitlist will be established. To qualify for the waitlist, new member applicants are required to first join the Club as a Silver member at the applicable Silver rates. The new member applicant will then complete a Gold member waitlist application.

If an existing Silver member wants to be added to the waitlist, they must complete a Gold member waitlist application. If an existing Bronze member wants to be added to the waitlist, they must upgrade to Silver by paying the applicable fees, and also complete the Gold member waitlist application.

The Gold waitlist priority will be first come, first served. Once contacted that a Gold membership is available, a member has 30 days to accept the Gold level membership and pay the applicable fees to upgrade. If a member declines the Gold membership when offered to them, they can choose to be removed from the list or will be repositioned to the bottom of the waiting list.

When the Club calculates the Gold nonrefundable equity contribution required at the time of upgrade to Gold, the club will use the difference between the Gold and Silver rates which were in place at the time the member joined the waitlist provided the upgrade is within twelve months of first being placed on the list. If the upgrade is not within twelve months of first being placed on the waitlist, the club will use the difference between the Silver rate paid at time of joining and the current Gold rate.

If a waitlist is established and is in use, a member who sells their home could offer their Gold membership to the buyer of the home, and that buyer would be eligible for immediate Gold membership. The reissuance of a new membership would in all cases be through the Club, using the standard application process and payment of the applicable fees.

**Additional note: while a waitlist in in place, if a Gold member decides to resign prior to the end of the calendar year, they can notify the club and they will receive a pro-rated refund for their yearly dues, and their membership will be terminated prior to the end of the year. This will only be in place while there are people waiting on the waitlist.
